































What to Bring to Camp:

-  Bible & pen/pencil (don't come to church camp without your Bible!)
-  Backpack or large tote bag
- Money for offering and gift shop
-  Items requested for Love in Action Ministry Project
-  Items needed for craft choice (*if applicable*)
-  Pillow & sleeping bag or sheets for regular sized twin bed
-  Bottled water to keep with you AT ALL TIMES (most cabins have refrigerators)
-  Soap, shampoo & towels, extra towel(s) for pool and lake times
-  Medicine & personal items
-  Flashlight
-  Disposable camera
-  Insect repellent
-  Sunscreen
-  One-piece swimsuit & cover-up (a dark-colored t-shirt must be worn at all times over any 2-piece swimsuit)
-  Rain jacket or poncho (no umbrellas)
-  Lightweight jacket or sweatshirt for chilly mornings
-  Jeans & tennis shoes; required for hiking, Zip Line & Adventure Course, recommended for campfire
-  **Comfortable** flip flops & sandals are suitable... but remember, you will walk about 4 miles each day around campus so dress wisely
-  Comfortable shorts of suitable length are acceptable for all activities -- **no tank tops or spaghetti straps**, please dress modestly
-  LABEL EVERYTHING!!

Sponsors May Find These Items Useful:

-  Alarm clock
-  Small medical kit containing items such as Band-Aids, first aid cream, feminine pads
-  Backpack
-  Extra pens or pencils for campers during Bible study and quiet times
-  Permanent marker for labeling campers' personal items not marked before camp
-  Extra soap and paper towels for the bathroom sink
-  Trash bags (useful for extra garbage bags, impromptu craft smocks, rain ponchos, etc.)

What NOT to Bring to Camp:

-  Electronics, such as cell phone, CD player, DVD player, TV, radio, MP3 player, iPod, iPad, laptop computer, handheld games, Kindle
-  Jewelry
-  Credit/debit cards
-  Anything else of value
